

CONDITIONS FOR ACCEPTANCE

Small household appliances and ICT equipment

DESCRIPTION

Brown goods fall within the waste electrical and electronic equipment regulations (WEEE) and comprise:

- Small household appliances
- ICT equipment

Permitted

- Small household appliances; radios, amplifiers, stereo systems, cassettes, record players, videos, cameras, speakers, kettles, deep fryers, toasters, mixers, garden equipment, vacuum cleaners, sewing machines, flatirons, hairdryers and shavers, medical devices and measuring instruments.
- ICT equipment; telephone and fax machines, mobile phones, copiers, printers, computer mice and keyboards.

Prohibited

- Hazardous (chemical) waste such as: mercury switches, glass from cathode ray tubes and other activated glass
- Industrial waste
- Asbestos or suspect asbestos-containing materials
- Condensers
- Televisions – tube and flat panel
- White goods
- Devices contaminated with water, food, chemical waste, oil or grease.
- Devices that have been in contact with radiation and/or body fluids without a decontamination statement on each individual device.
